



Student Enrollment Fact Sheet - Tuition Schedule 2020-21 - Grades K-12

The following structure will be in place for the 2020-21 school year. Please be aware that timely payment of tuition is absolutely necessary in order for the child to remain an enrolled student at Science and Math Institute.

Application Fee \$25.00 per student Due when application is submitted, NON REFUNDABLE
Enrollment Fee \$200.00 per student

Must be paid upon receipt of Enrollment form. **Inquire with administration to determine if your current scholarship will cover a portion of Re-enrollment*

The following fees are due by August 15, 2018

**Inquire with the front office to determine if your scholarship will pay for a portion of these fees*

Tuition Payment Options:

- Annually: Receive all tuition in full by August 1, 2020 and receive a 5% discount
**Families that receive a partial scholarship, may receive a discount if paid in full by Aug 1*
- Monthly: Monthly payments are paid in 10 months, beginning Aug. 1, 2020 and ending June 1, 2020. Monthly payments are billed on the 1st and due by the 10th of each month. A \$25 late fee will be assessed for each payment that is late.

Scholarships: Your child **MAY** qualify for a scholarship. If you wish to find out more information, please call the front office.

- Step-Up for Students Scholarship: based on household income
- John McKay: students with an IEP or 504 Plan
- PLSA: students with a disability as diagnosed by an IEP or a doctor
- AAA Scholarship: students with a disability or with low household income
- Other Local, Regional or National Scholarships that are excepted SAMi

SAMI Scholarship: Families that have reached a difficult time due to unforeseen circumstances or circumstances out of their control, may apply for a SAMi Scholarship. Scholarships are awarded on a first come first serve basis, and are only awarded as a ‘short-term’ assistance. Families that are awarded the scholarship must meet certain qualifications.

Volunteer Hours: SAMi’s everyday operations depend upon the active involvement of its families. Each Parent/Guardian will be required to provide 20 hours (35 hours for families) of volunteer service per year. Any Parent/Guardian that is unable to meet these requirements can buy their hours at \$200 (or \$10 per hour). Any volunteer that has direct contact with a student will have to have a background check prior to volunteering (cost paid by volunteer).

Important Reminder: Upon submission of re-enrollment, any parent that receives a SAMi scholarship award, outside of Step-Up and McKay, you are committed to the semester’s tuition whether your child actually attends or not. (See Statement of Financial Agreements)

Science and Math Institute ask for a financial commitment for those who re-enroll / enroll for next year. Enrollment or re-enrollment is a commitment from the parents to pay for one-semester tuition even if the child withdraws prior to the first day of the next school year.

- The school takes commitments very seriously. This commitment will bind two parties together.
- The school commits to the parents to provide a full year of education which requires a full years tuition payments the school is committed to be here for the child and plans each year’s expenditures based on enrollment numbers.
- The school depends on tuition payments to pay for expenses. Expenses for the school include salaries for staff members, copiers, computer maintenance, and software updates, as well as curriculum supplies, testing, textbooks, lab supplies, and many more items that your child enjoys throughout the school year. The school budget is based on the commitments of the parents to send their child(ren) to the school. Once contractual relationships are made, the School cannot undo these contracts.

Statement of Cooperation

I (We) hereby make application for my child to attend the Science and Math Institute. In making this application, I (We) understand and agree to comply with and abide by the provisions of the student handbook and the rules and standards set out, including but not limited to the following:

1. SAMi has the right to dismiss any student who does not respect the school's academic and behavioral standards or does not cooperate in its educational process.
2. I (We) agree to cooperate with the school policies and procedures. I (We) agree to publicly support the school and bring whatever concerns I (We) have to the proper individuals per school policy and procedures.
3. I (We) agree to cooperate with the school's dress code policy and I (We) understand that I (We) will be held accountable for my child's adherence to that policy.
4. I (We) agree that I (We) and my student will represent the school well. This includes behavior off-campus, in the virtual world, and during school sponsored activities such as field trips.

Statement of Financial Agreements

I (We) understand that the enrollment fee is given as consideration to ensure that my child has a slot at SAMI during the next school year. I (We) understand that this fee **will not be refunded** under any circumstance if my child is offered a slot. Only if the child is not offered a slot, will the enrollment fee be refunded.

Fall Semester Withdrawals:

I (We) understand that should we seek to withdraw our child(ren) from SAMi after signing this enrollment form and being accepted into next semester's enrollment, that we are responsible for paying the full first semester of tuition. The school has agreed to hold a slot for our child and the parent has agreed to pay the first semester's tuition. This is a mutual agreement by both parties. This charge will be placed on students account and is not dependent on any applicable scholarships student may qualify for.

Spring Semester

All requests for withdrawals for the spring semester must be made in November. Withdrawal after November will result in a withdrawal charge of a semester's tuition payment if monthly semester tuition previously paid toward the semester's costs. Enrollment fees do not count against withdrawal charges. In the case a scholarship was provided for tuition that scholarship will be returned to the awarding entity. At that time the students account will be charged and a hold will be placed on the students account. It will be the parent/guardian's responsibility to pay this fee.

I (We) understand that if we should seek to withdraw our child(ren) without clearing our financial indebtedness then:

- I (We) have forfeited our right to ask SAMi to transfer the records on our child(ren) to another school until we have cleared our indebtedness
 - I (We) have subjected ourselves to the legally-binding arbitration process as prescribed in the "conciliation clause" which is included in this enrollment packet.
1. I (We) understand that the school has made commitments to the teachers for resources, etc. based upon my commitment to pay the tuition requirements. I (We) understand that if I (We) withdraw my child from school prior to the beginning of or during the first Fall Semester, I (We) will still be liable for the entire fall tuition even though my child may not attend. In this way, the school can still meet its commitments they have made.
 2. Tuition payments: Fall payments: September, October, November, December, January Spring payments: February, March, April, May, June
 3. Payments are billed on the 1st of each month and due by the 10th of each month.
 4. Initial late fee of \$25 of each month, additional late fee of \$10 after the 25th of each month
